Under Maharashtra Self-aided Schools (Establishment and Regulation) Act, 2012

Elam VachchhalaGopi Foundation, Patil Nagar, Ward No. 5, Kandri, Nagpur, has approved the establishment of VachchhalaGopi Public School, Survey No. 264/2, Patil Nagar, Kandri, Kanhan, Tal. Parshivni, Dist. Nagpur (Primary to Higher Secondary, Class 1 to Class 12, English Medium, CBSE, All Branches) was submitted for starting a new school on self-aided basis.

- 2. In connection with your application, under the Maharashtra Self-Aided Schools (Establishment and Regulation) Act, 2012 and the Maharashtra Self-Aided Schools (Establishment and Regulation) Rules, 2020, from the academic year 2022-23, Elam VachchhalaGopi Foundation, Patil Nagar, Ward No. 5, Kandri, Nagpur, VachchhalaGopi Public School, Plot No. 264/2, Patil Nagar, Kandri, Kanhan, Tal. Parshivni, Dist. Nagpur (Primary to Higher Secondary, Class 1 to Class 12, English Medium, CBSE, All Branches) Letter of Intent was given with terms and conditions to start the construction of a school on self-financing basis. Now approval to start the said new school from the academic year 2023-24 is being given subject to the following terms and conditions:-
- 3. Terms and Conditions:-1) The proposed school shall comply with all the standards, terms and conditions prescribed by the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and the Maharashtra Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 and the directions given by the Government under this Act or any standards or norms specified by the Government from time to time.
- 2) It is mandatory for the registered institution or trust or company to comply with all the norms, terms and conditions prescribed by the Maharashtra Self-Aided Schools (Establishment and Regulation) Act, 2012 and the directions issued by the Government under this Act or the norms or terms and conditions specified by the Government from time to time.

- 3) It is mandatory for the school managements desirous of affiliation to a board like C.B.S.E. or C.I.S.C.E. or C.A.I.E. or I.B. etc. to obtain a no-objection certificate from the Government as per the directions issued by the Government from time to time.
- 4) The school management shall inform the concerned district education officer before the commencement of the academic year approved by the Government.
- 5) The permission granted under the provisions of this Act to establish a new school or to upgrade the status of a school shall be for the same academic year for which it is approved.
- 6) If the school management fails to start the school within 18 months, the approval granted shall be cancelled.
- 7) The school management cannot change the approved medium of education or the location of the school in future without the permission of the Government.
- 8) If the school management establishes a school at a place other than the place approved by the Government, the permission of that school will be cancelled.
- 9) It has been provided that the recruitment of teachers and non-teaching staff in self-financed schools should be done as per the prevailing rules and regulations of the Government.
- 10) While filling the district-wise information, the school which has been granted permission shall enter the information as "Self-aided School" as a separate category and shall obtain U.D.I.S.E. number. In this regard, the State Project Director, Maharashtra Primary Education Council, Mumbai has been declared as the nodal officer.
- 11) The school management shall put up a board at the entrance of the school premises stating "Self-aided Permitted School".
- 12) The State Government may cancel the permission granted at any time on the ground of violation of any provision of this Act or the rules made thereunder or failure to comply with any directions given under the Act or the standards or norms specified by the Government from time to time or the terms and conditions.
